The heart begins beating just 18 days after fertilization, eventually pumping blood twice as fast as the adult heart, beating over 54 million times before birth.



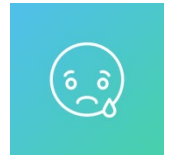
When pregnant mothers experience distress, the baby sends stem cells to her damaged organs to repair them. She sends antibodies to her baby that protect against infectious diseases.



At eight weeks the retinas form and the eyes begin to move in response to light four weeks later.

Fingerprints were etched into the skin by nine weeks as sensitivity to touch developed.

Although no one could hear because of the aquatic environment, babies cry in the womb. The sound of the cry is influenced by the language heard before birth.



In four short weeks babies grow 10,000 times bigger than the fertilized egg. In nine short months, babies weigh six billion times more than that egg.



At just seven weeks old and one inch long every adult organ is present. Detectable brainwaves first appear after only six weeks.

The taste for music is formed in the womb along with the cochlea (organ of the inner ear), which reached adult size by 20 weeks.
