General chiropractic education takes a minimum of 7 academic years. Before admission to chiropractic college, a student must take two years' worth of basic science courses, including anatomy, physiology, chemistry, physics, English, & psychology. A typical chiropractic curriculum is four academic years or ten trimesters, with a total of 4800 hours in lecture, laboratory, and clinical experience.
